Dear Collierville United Methodist Church,

On behalf of the Board and Volunteers of the Family Violence Council of Collierville, I would like to thank you for your very generous donation of \$811.72. These funds will be especially useful in helping our survivors and their families in our attempt to provide assistance and education for survivors of domestic violence.

As you may know, over 30 percent of American women report being physically or sexually abused by a husband or boyfriend at some point in their lives and over 3 million children are at risk of exposure to parental violence each year. In addition, 40 percent of girls age 14-17 report knowing someone their age that has been hit or beaten by a boyfriend. The Family Violence Council continues to provide resources such as emergency shelter for domestic violence survivors, free counseling for domestic violence survivors, and Court Advocacy for domestic violence survivors. Your donation helps us to continue to provide needed resources to our community and we are extremely grateful. Since no goods or services were exchanged as a result of this donation, it is fully tax deductible by law.
